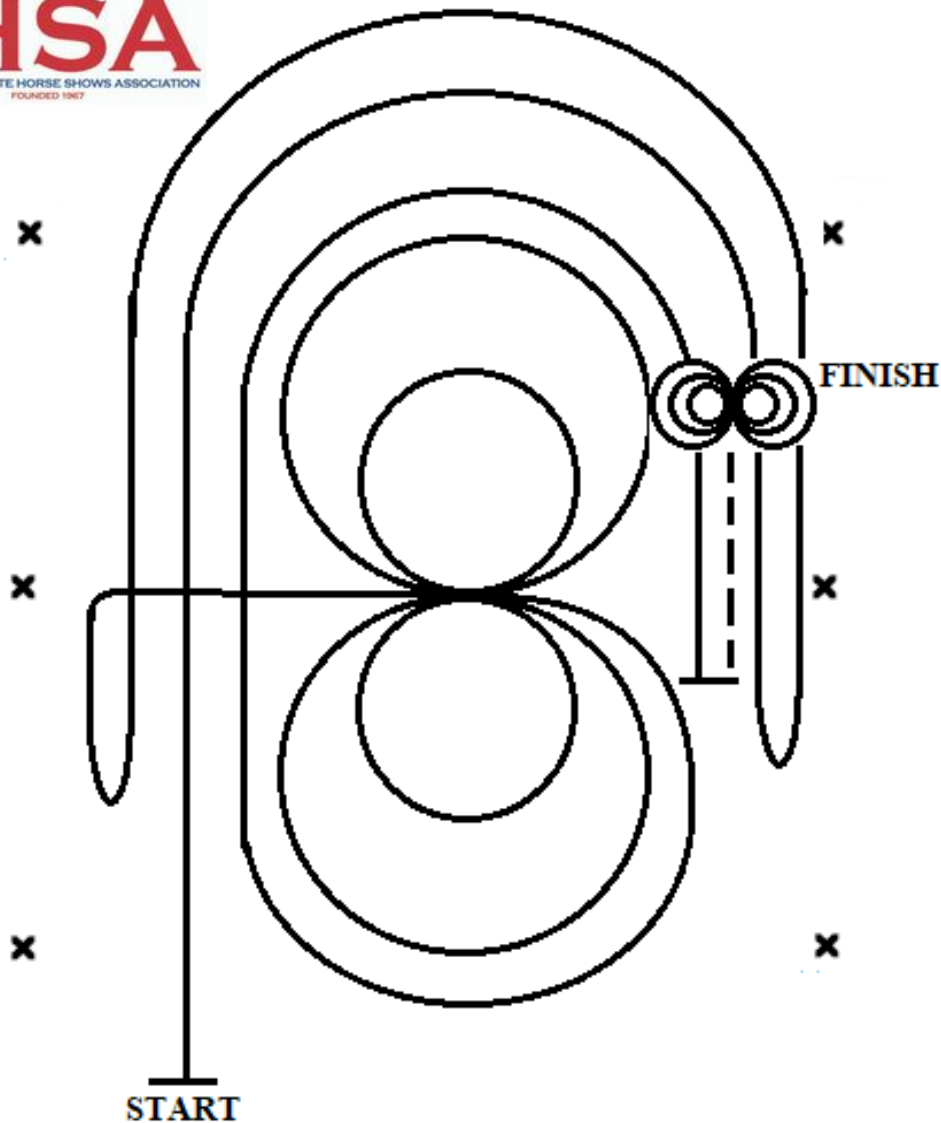




# IHSA REINING PATTERN 9



NOTE: The drawn description of this pattern is only intended for the general depiction of the pattern. Contestants should utilize the arena space to best exhibit their horses.

1. Starting on the left side wall, lope down around end wall, back up the right side past the center marker. Stop and roll back left.
2. Continue down right wall around end wall, back up left side past the center marker. Stop and roll back right.
3. Continue up left wall to center. At the center marker, horse should be on the right lead. Continue to the center of the arena.
4. At the center of the arena, complete two circles to the right, the first being large and fast, the second being slow and small.
5. Do a simple lead change and complete two circles to the left, the first being large and fast, the second being slow and small.

6. Do a simple lead change and begin a large circle to the right but do not close this circle. Continue up the left side around the end wall back down the right side past the center marker. Stop.
7. Back and hesitate.
8. Complete three spins to the right.
9. Complete three spins to the left.
