

Pay It Forward . . .

Pay It Forward offers the opportunity for IHSA Teams to raise funds and benefit the welfare of horses by conducting on-site visits of equine charities selected by the EQUUS Foundation in their vicinity.

Up to eight \$500 service awards may be awarded annually. The winners will be selected from among the participating teams and announced at the IHSA Nationals each year.



Sounds Complicated? It's Not!

The EQUUS Foundation:

- Identifies the organization that requires a site visit and invites the team to participate.
- Explains what is involved with conducting a site visit and the use of our site visit assessment form to the participating team.
- Records the completed site visitor assessment form information.

The participating IHSA Team:

- Arranges a convenient time to visit the charity.
- Completes the site visitor assessment form either during the visit or immediately afterwards.
- Submits the completed site visitor assessment form to us via email or mail.

Questions?

If an IHSA Team conducts more than one site visit, does the team have more opportunity to win? Yes.

The participating IHSA Team gets credit for each site visit conducted. The more site visits conducted by the IHSA Team, the more opportunities to win a service award.

Does the whole team have to participate? No.

The site visit is conducted by a coach or faculty advisor and at least one member.

What is the time commitment?

The site visit can be completed in one or two hours plus transportation time to and from the facility. The site visit assessment form may be completed during the site visit or immediately afterwards.
