

Conveniently located just off westbound I-10, the NMSU Student Learning Center Arena sits on the main New Mexico State University campus within the agriculture complex. The nearest airport is **El Paso International Airport (50 miles)**, offering the most direct and accessible route. Alternative options include **Albuquerque International Sunport (225 miles)** and **Tucson International Airport (270 miles)**.



Las Cruces offers a true taste of the Southwest with a blend of history, culture, and outdoor adventure. Just minutes from campus, visitors can explore Historic Old Mesilla, known for its charming plaza, unique shops, and authentic New Mexican dining. Outdoor enthusiasts can hike the nearby Organ Mountains–Desert Peaks National Monument, explore the scenic Dripping Springs Natural Area, or enjoy a peaceful walk along the Rio Grande. The New Mexico Farm and Ranch Heritage Museum, located adjacent to NMSU, offers an engaging look at the region's agricultural traditions. Food lovers won't want to miss tasting the area's famous red and green Chile dishes or savoring delicious Mexican cuisine at one of Las Cruces' many local restaurants. For a day trip, White Sands National Park, just an hour away, features stunning gypsum dunes and unforgettable desert views.

Directions: Get on I-10 from Airway Blvd, follow I-10 for 47 miles. Take exit 142 E. University Ave. (0.9 miles), right on El Paseo Rd/ Union Ave (0.3 miles), left on Sam Steele Way {overflow parking located on the left in dirt lot} and left on Gregg St into dirt parking on left by the silos.

Parking lot located on the south side of the Student Learning Center Arena on Gregg St with overflow parking located off of Sam Steele Way and Stewart St.
