Due to restrictions on arena size and evenness of horses all individual classes will be split into sections with a final round. The top eight riders will be called back for the individual class finals regardless of which section they rode in. The only exception to this will be Individual Reining and Alumni Horsemanship which will just run as a final. Awards will be given at the conclusion of the Finals of each individual class.
